6. Green School Programme:

Centre for Science and Environment (CSE) Green Schools Programme is an environmental education programme directed to subtly sensitizing students to the environment through hands-on and thought provoking activities. It is also an environment management system that audits, through students, the consumption of natural resources within school campuses and helps schools become good environmental managers by deploying pragmatic solutions to reduce wastage of precious resources.

QSP Processes

1. **Home Mentoring:** The Parental Engagement Process is a step towards strengthening the teacher-parent student relationship to ensure a more inclusive, engaging, and effective learning environment for children. By empowering families with simple yet impactful strategies, we can create a supportive ecosystem that fosters academic success, creativity, and life skills—aligning with the vision of NEP 2020 for holistic child development.

The process shall be implemented in selected grades. (IV-V for primary sections and VI-VIII for elementary sections). Where there are multiple sections in one grade, one particular section can be picked up for the implementation.

Case-control method with 40% (min.)-50% (max.) sample size shall be implemented for the measurement of effectiveness of Home Mentoring process. The questionnaire can be integrated into HPC wherever it is being implemented. Teachers can have these filled out during PTMs scheduled towards the end of home mentoring process, with the field team following up as needed. (Case – third year of intervention; Control- first year of intervention)

3. National Means Cum-merit Scholarship Scheme (NMMSS):

The Centrally Sponsored Scheme "National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme (NMMSS)" was launched in May, 2008. The objective of the scheme is to award scholarships to meritorious students of economically weaker sections to arrest their drop out at class VIII and encourage them to continue the study at secondary stage. Scholarship of Rs. 6000/- per annum (Rs.500/- per month) per student is awarded to selected students every year for study in classes from IX to XII in State Government, Government aided and local body schools. There is quota of scholarships for different states/UTs. Students whose parental income from all sources is not more than Rs. 1,50,000/- are eligible to avail the scholarships. There is reservation as per State Government norms. The selection of students award of the scholarships is made through an examination conducted by the State Governments. Scholarships are disbursed by the State Bank of India directly into the bank accounts of students on quarterly basis.

4. School Enterprise Challenge:

It is an opportunity for school students to become entrepreneur. Students take the lead to set up a school-based business that generates real profits which they can use to support their school, wider community or a social cause. This is a school national level award. During the course of the programme, students learn about business (market research, financial literacy, etc.) and they also develop essential life skills (communication, problem solving, leadership, etc.) that they will need to succeed in the real world.

Requesting all state teams to submit their **STEP 1 & 2 (Business Idea and Business Plan)** by 31st August 2025.

5. IT Innovation Best Idea (Internal Competition):
